Regional Interview Days Need-Based Travel Grants

The Office of Career Services has limited funds available to subsidize travel/transportation costs associated with participation in Regional Interview Days held in Chicago, Washington, D.C., New York and Boston. Only those who intend to accept their interviews and participate in the program should apply for grants.

How to Apply/Requirements:

- Students must demonstrate financial need by submitting an estimated budget and short statement of need. *Degree of financial need will also be determined through the Office of Financial Aid.*
- Applications are accepted on a rolling basis with the final deadline of 5pm on Monday, November 21, 2011. Students participating in the Chicago interview day should submit materials as soon as possible.
- Complete applications include:
 - A copy of your resume
 - A statement, not to exceed one page, explaining your interest in attending Regional Interview Day(s)
 - An estimated budget of expenses and statement of need

Selection Process:

- Career Services will review application materials, financial need and estimated budget to determine the allocation of funds.
- Students will be notified no later than Monday, November 28, 2011 whether they have received a grant.
- Recipients will be reimbursed for their expenses, up to the amount awarded, after Regional Interview Days. *Special circumstances may be reviewed in order to make awards prior to travel.*
- Recipients must submit original receipts and an expense report no later than Friday, February 10, 2011 in order to receive reimbursement up to the amount of the grant award.
