## **WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTION AND DRINKING WATER BOIL ADVISORY NOTICE**

Dear Oberlin Water Customer,

On Thursday, November 5, 2009, between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., the water main on East College Street between Main Street and Park Street, Pleasant Street between Lorain Street and East Vine Street and Prosser Court, will be off for water main construction. A Boil the Drinking Water Advisory will be in effect when the water service is restored.

During an Advisory, customers are asked to boil their tap water, to insure safe water by heat purification. Boil the water **vigorously for one (1) minute**, then allow the water to cool before using. People with special health considerations should follow their doctor's advice during an advisory.

This advisory will only be for the affected area(s) in which the water main was without pressure and subject to contamination. It is probable that surrounding areas are not affected by this notice. If you received a notice, you are advised that your residence or business should comply when using water for human consumption. Examples would include **drinking, cooking, making ice, dish washing, and dental hygiene.**

After the repair, samples will be collected and analyzed. Test procedures will require **24 hours or longer.** End of Boil Advisory Notices will be issued as soon as the tests indicate that the water is safe to drink. Thank you for your cooperation in following these guidelines established by the Environmental Protection Agency to safeguard your health.
