

Subsequent Enrollments of Students Withdrawing from Oberlin College

Since 1980, Oberlin has undertaken several studies of student persistence to graduation. While we have learned more about how student characteristics and experiences contribute to persistence, we have been largely unable to determine what happens to those students who eventually withdraw from Oberlin. The most common question in this regard is to what extent withdrawals continue their education at another institution. Periodic surveys have shed some light on this but for the first time, we have systematically collected information on the subsequent enrollments of these students using data from the National Student Loan Clearinghouse (NSLC).

Despite their name, NSLC does not limit its data collection to student loan recipients. They now have data, at the student record level, of enrollments at ninety-one percent of the colleges and universities in the country. By paying a modest annual fee, institutions can participate in data exchanges with NSLC and receive identifiable student information¹ with enrollment information for admit/cancels through graduation.

The population selected for this analysis consisted of any student with a Banner record (beginning fall 1999) who withdrew from Oberlin and did not re-enroll at Oberlin through the beginning of the spring semester, 2003:

Of this number, NSLC found 455 students in their database and matched 321 (71%, likely an underestimate given NSLC participation) with enrollments at other institutions after they had withdrawn from Oberlin. Twenty of those students either enrolled at institutions that block NSLC from releasing detail data to other institutions or have blocked their information themselves. We therefore have transfer data on 301 of the 455 students who withdrew from Oberlin. We can assume that some larger number actually enrolled at another institution but that number cannot be determined nor estimated. The breakdown of *known* transfers as a percentage of the population of withdrawals is as follows:

Once we know these numbers, we are quickly drawn to the questions; at what kinds of institutions do these students enroll and can we infer anything from that answer?

The list of transfer institutions is impressive in both its number and diversity. The complete list is attached to this report but categorizing the institutions by type, control, Carnegie Classification etc., is a better way to attempt to answer our questions. Thankfully, NSLC provides the Federal Interagency Committee on Education (FICE) code for the transfer institutions, therefore allowing us to link the file to NCES data on institutional characteristics. We were able to match all but eleven of the institutions to the NCES data giving us good data on the kinds of institutions our withdrawn students transfer to:³

We are immediately struck by the fact that the majority of transfers enroll at public research universities and may assume that cost is a primary factor for both withdrawing and subsequent enrollment. While this may be to some extent true, the NCES data points us into other directions.

The average in-state cost⁴ incurred by students transferring to other institutions is \$20, 551. Out-of-state costs average \$25,103. Oberlin's cost for the comparable year was \$25,348. These differences are not insignificant, however they are not large. The range of costs for the transfer institutions is rather expansive however - \$5,700 to \$35,752. Lower cost may indeed be a reason for some of the withdrawing students but we see very little difference in costs incurred across ethnicity and gender. In other words, if lower cost is a reason, it does not appear to be differentiated across ethnic groups.

The most striking difference in institutional characteristics across ethnicity is the percentage of students who are Black/non-Hispanic at the transfer institutions:

These differences may be an artifact of the types of transfer institutions chosen for other reasons but we cannot deny that the differences are more noticeable than differences in cost. We cannot assume that African American students are withdrawing from Oberlin and transferring to institutions with higher black/non-Hispanic enrollments *because* of those enrollments but there is a stronger case for that than transferring for cost. It is also supported somewhat by previous surveys and anecdotal evidence.

Data from the NSLC is not limited to analyses of withdrawn students. We can use it to get more information on the educational trajectories of our graduates. The Director of our Upward Bound Program also plans to use it to track post-secondary enrollments of program participants. We can also bring in other data from the NCES such as financial position, financial aid profiles and graduate rates of transfer institutions. If Oberlin agrees to participate in the DegreeVerify service, we can get information on degrees completed by students once enrolled at Oberlin. It's clear that NSLC is a valuable tool as we attempt to learn more about student experiences after Oberlin, regardless of how they leave Oberlin and I strongly recommend that we continue to pay the \$300 annual fee to participate in the data exchanges.
