Obie Dollars must be purchased in increments of \$25.

The Obie Dollars Program is a prepaid debit card program that allows students to use their ID card to purchase goods and services both on and off campus. The Obie Dollar declining balance account is encoded on the student's College ID card.

On campus, students can use Obie Dollars to pay for copies at the copy machines in the College libraries, printing in computing center printer labs, and laundry machines in several residence halls. Each student receives a printing allowance per semester and then pays for additional printing per page.

Students may also use Obie Dollars to buy à la carte food or meals at any of the Campus Dining Services (CDS) dining halls or retail operations, including Azariah's Café, to supplement their weekly meals or CDS Flex Points.

A number of downtown merchants, including food, clothing, and book stores, accept Obie Dollars. To view a current list of participating stores, go to the Office of Residential Education and Dining Services web site (www.oberlin.edu/resed) and click on the QuickLink for *Obie Dollars*.

Obie Dollars is a convenient and safe way for students to make purchases without having to carry cash. Students are

not permitted to make cash withdrawals from their Obie Dollars account. Obie Dollars cannot be used to purchase alcohol or tobacco products.

Participating in the Program

To participate in the Obie Dollars Program, complete the deposit form below or download it online. Return the form with your check to the address listed at the top of this form.

Deposits received by Tuesday, August 18, 2009, will be processed before Orientation begins. When the student arrives on campus and picks up his or her ID card, the Obie Dollars account will be encoded and ready to use.

The balance in an account can be increased in \$25 increments throughout the year, either by mail or in person at the Office of Residential Education and Dining Services. Hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Deposits of less than \$25 can be made by inserting cash into one of the value transfer stations in the main or science libraries; these deposits are available for immediate use.

Your account will remain open until you leave Oberlin, unless you request otherwise. Accounts may be closed, upon written request, for a fee when leaving the College.
