Conference Parking

For convenient and hassle free parking throughout the conference weekend, please follow these simple steps:

1 While checking in for the conference, ask the friendly Folk Music Club folks for a parking permit for dashboard display;

2 Park in any of the "G" lots surrounding Hales Gym. From Wilder Hall, proceed north on Woodland Street and turn left into the parking lot across from the Science Center. Beyond the first two rows of "K" spaces, turn left or right...or proceed forward to the opposite side of the building...and park in the G rated space of your choosing;
