Overview:

Reunion and Class Giving Director

Responsibilities:

- Meet with fellow committee members to develop ideas for class specific programming and events.
- Recruit additional reunion volunteers to support planning efforts in the coming year, if necessary.
- Encourage classmates to attend reunion through outreach efforts.
- Encourage classmates to contribute financially to support your reunion year.

Location:

Most activities are completed virtually through Zoom meetings and in-person on campus during reunion weekend.

Time commitment:

Generally, virtual meetings leading up to reunion weekend are monthly for one-hour, but other times may be needed if planning an event or reaching out to classmates. The total volunteer time commitment per month is between 3-6 hours.

We welcome any Oberlin alumni who are interested in planning reunion events and working to engage with other alumni in their class or cluster. (You do not need to be a class officer. There is no election process.)
