

Who should complete this form? This form is intended for current Oberlin students who wish to switch between the Bachelor of Arts (BA) and the Bachelor of Science (BS) degree programs, including students in the double-degree program seeking to switch between Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Music (BA/BM) and Bachelor of Science/Bachelor of Music (BS/BM).

Students seeking to make other changes to their degree program should consult the [Change of Degree Program](#) page for instructions.

Eligibility for the Bachelor of Science

To convert your degree from the BA to the BS, you must be declared in at least one of the following majors: biochemistry, biology, business, chemistry, computer science, data science, economics, environmental science, financial economics, geosciences, global health, mathematics, neuroscience, physics, or psychology. (Students can pursue these majors either with the BS or the BA but not both.)

If you are not currently declared in a BS-eligible major, you should use the major declaration form to declare a BS-eligible major and indicate your intention to pursue the BS degree program.

How to Obtain Required Signatures

- Option 1: directly on the form as pen-to-paper signatures or by using Adobe’s electronic signature feature
- Option 2: email approvals
- Option 3: a mix of options one and two
