Application Packet must include the following:

- 1. A brief introduction of the message and focus of your speech (include topic and key points).
- 2. A full draft of the speech; double-spaced (no bullet points). Please note that the commencement speech is limited to 5 minutes
- 3. *A video via YouTube of yourself presenting your full commencement address (*Note: Please test the YouTube link before submitting*) Submissions without a full video commencement address will not be considered.
- 4. Your current resume. Please include your achievements, organizations, and activities you engage in at Oberlin College.

Topics to Consider While Writing Your Speech

- The transformative power of an Oberlin education.
- Information about your personal development and future outlook.
- How your personal experiences shaped your educational journey at Oberlin and developed a desire for you to want to make a change in the world.
- Include examples from collegiate life, course work, co-curricular involvement, service, peer and other relationships developed.

The speech should:

- Utilize sophisticated and inspiring, yet accessible, language.
- Appeal to and capture the attention of a broad audience.
- Include creative and appealing techniques such as metaphors, stories, quotes, or humor.
- Illuminate the universal experience of being a student.
- Be no more than five (5) minutes in length, or approximately 750 to 900 words.
