Policy Purpose: ALCOHOL USAGE in Wilder and Hales Annex

Policy Statement: Recitals & Receptions: The serving of alcohol at recitals and receptions is discouraged.

Policy Scope/Eligibility: Should someone want an exception, they will need to meet with the Director of Student Activities/Student Union. Groups are required to use the catering department of Oberlin College or an outside caterer with a liquor license. Use of alcohol in the Student Union (Wilder Hall and Hales Annex) is forbidden except in the Dionysus Nightclub and according to the guidelines above.

Policy Administration: Director of Student Activities

Policy Procedures: Any organization desiring to serve alcohol at their event must comply with the Residence Hall party planning guidelines as delineated in the College Rules and Regulations. Written documentation from the office of Residential Life & Services will be required before any alcohol authorization is granted by the Student Union. In addition, the following Student Union restrictions are to be followed:

- I. In addition to the alcohol, a non-alcoholic beverage and food must be served for the duration of the event.
- II. All alcohol must be strictly confined to the reserved room.
- III. It is the responsibility of the organization to clean-up all food and beverages. Violations of this will result in a fine and potential loss of future scheduling privileges.
