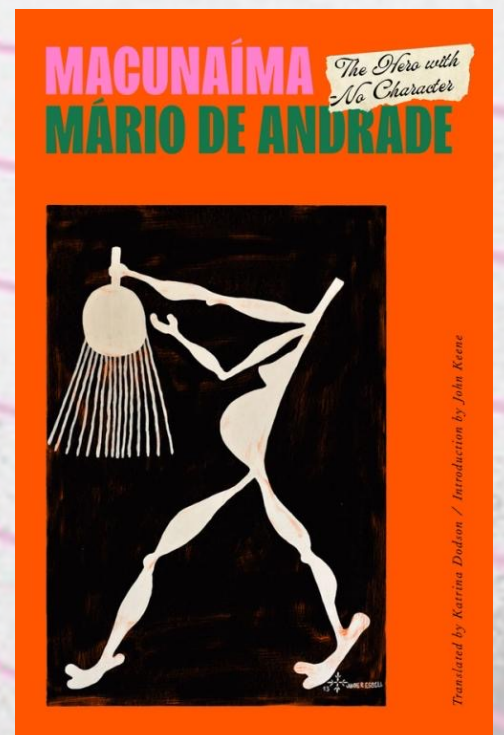
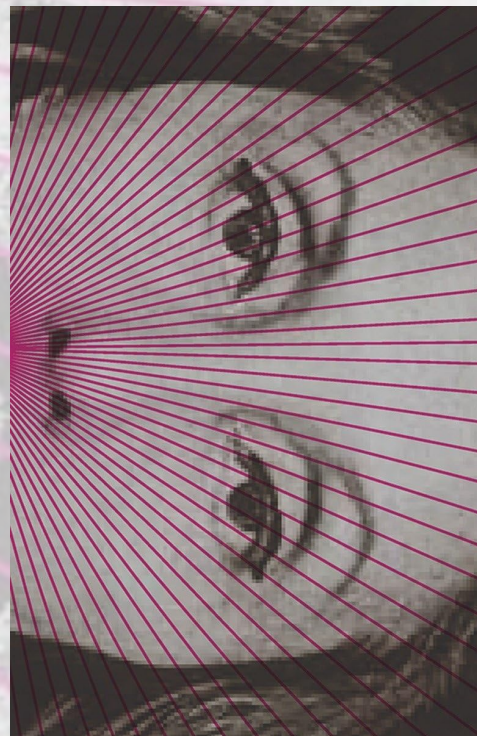
KATRINA DODSON THE PARADOX OF THE UNTRANSLATABLE

Katrina Dodson is the translator of *The Complete Stories* by Clarice Lispector (New Directions, 2015), winner of the PEN Translation Prize and other awards. Her translation of Mário de Andrade's 1928 Brazilian modernist classic, *Macunaíma: The Hero with No Character*, received a National Endowment for the Arts fellowship and was published by New Directions in 2023 and by Fitzcarraldo in the UK. Dodson holds a PhD in Comparative Literature from the University of California, Berkeley, and teaches translation at Columbia University.
