

2018 An Family Foundation Korean Language Summer Study Scholarship

Eligibility: Freshman, Sophomore or Junior East Asian Studies majors/minors are given preference. History or Politics majors will also be considered. Applicants who have successfully completed or are currently enrolled in Korean ExCo classes are given preference.

The application must include:

- Unofficial Oberlin transcript.
- Personal Statement: Applicants are required to submit a personal statement (approx. 700 words, single-spaced) answering all the following questions: “What do you want to gain from the summer study?” “How did you become interested in Korean language and culture?” “How can this summer program help you to further your studies in Oberlin?”
- Recommendation letters: Applicants are required to submit two recommendation letters. One from an East Asian Studies faculty member and the other from the applicants’ faculty of choice. The letters must be sent directly by the recommender to the East Asian Studies office. Letters can also be sent via email to Professor Sheila Miyoshi Jager (sjager@oberlin.edu).
