

# Coordinated Protest Protocol for College-Sponsored Events the Oberlin Hotel Oberlin College, The Hotel at Oberlin, Oberlin City Police Department

February 15, 2023 Revision

## Commitment to Collaboration

Oberlin College, the Hotel at Oberlin management team, and the Oberlin City Police Department desire to work collaboratively to provide effective community-based safety services for college sponsored events at the hotel. Working together, we aim to: (1) minimize unlawful activity in a private business setting; (2) respect community members' rights to assembly and expression; and the community's history of social activism and collective action; (3) use best practices of community policing and crowd management techniques to effectively and quickly restore normal business operations in response to disruptive activity.

Oberlin College, the Hotel at Oberlin management team, and the Oberlin City Police Department recognize that developmentally appropriate interventions (e.g., de-escalation techniques, providing opportunities for individuals to make choices about the consequences they are willing to accept) are most effective to managing conduct of traditional college-aged adults.

Events that are likely to trigger this protocol include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Quarterly Oberlin College Board of Trustees Meetings (March, June, October, and December).
- 2. All Roads Lead to Oberlin Events (weekends in April).
- 3. Special events with controversial speakers.

## <u>Protocol</u>

- 1. Oberlin College Campus Safety will be responsible for providing safety at collegesponsored events at the hotel when anticipated protest or disruptive activity is known.
  - Campus Safety will appear in plain clothes when sufficient advance notice is provided.
  - Campus Safety will not engage in physical contact with protestors unless done so in self-defense from imminent physical harm.
  - Campus Safety will request OPD assistance when law enforcement presence is needed.
- 2. OPD is responsible for providing law enforcement services for activities outside of the hotel.
- 3. The hotel is responsible for advising Campus Safety and OPD of its standards for guests (e.g., no noise makers or sound amplification).
  - The hotel is encouraged to work with Campus Safety to manage disruptive conduct during college-sponsored events. In any and all incidents where there is a perceived emergency or a threat to the health or safety of anyone, 911 should be called.
