NOVEMBER 9, 2016 TO NOVEMBER 7, 2017

INITIAL INCIDENT AND PROTESTS

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9-FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2016

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2016

4:58 p.m. Students and others witness a physical altercation with Allyn D. Gibson and Oberlin students inside the bakery, outside the bakery, and ultimately in Tappan Square across the street from Gibson's Bakery. Three students are arrested.

10:18 p.m. Individual students plan a protest based upon the incident; distribute email.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2016

7:16 a.m. Dean of Students Meredith Raimondo learns of planned protest.

9:15 a.m. Oberlin official notifies Oberlin Police Department and local merchants of the planned student protests, including Gibson's Bakery.

11:00 a.m. Students start to gather and distribute flyers; 150-200 students and others protest.

2:53 p.m. Oberlin official reaches out to Gibson family to discuss situation.

11:15 p.m. Student Senate notifies President Marvin Krislov and Dean Raimondo that it has passed a resolution on the matter and distributed that resolution to the student body.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2016

11:00 a.m. Students reassemble to continue the protest.

12:07 p.m. Acting Oberlin Police Chief thanks Dean Raimondo for monitoring protest, which results in no property damage, arrests, or injuries.

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9-FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 2016

Initial incident and protests

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 12, 2016

Tensions escalate when counterprotestors arrive in Oberlin.

Oberlin administrators are provided a screenshot of a "Gibson's Bakery Support Page" on Facebook, which states that Gibson's Bakery appreciates the counterprotestors' support and that the bakery will "allow conceal carry, and will allow all 2nd Amendment Patriots to Open Carry."

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2016

Oberlin suspends placing daily orders for bakery products for the dining halls. All other business arrangements with the bakery continue.

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 2016

President Krislov meets with David Gibson and others at the President's House.

NOVEMBER 24-27, 2016

Thanksgiving Recess

JANUARY 3-25, 2017

Winter Term (dining services closed)

JANUARY 18, 2017

Dean of Students and Chief of Staff meet with David Gibson.

JANUARY 23, 2017

President Krislov issues a statement to the campus community indicating that the college is resuming standing orders with the bakery.

JANUARY 30, 2017

Spring Term begins

APRIL 27, 2017

Court of Common Pleas indictments filed against the three students, which included felony charge of robbery.

AUGUST 14, 2017

Sentencing hearing as a result of a plea deal that required the reading of a prepared statement.

NOVEMBER 7, 2017

Lawsuit against Oberlin College and Dean Raimondo filed.
