

APPLICATION FOR CONSERVATORY DEGREE RECITAL

To schedule a degree recital (Junior, Senior/MM/AD), please read the directions below and fill out the form on the reverse side. It **must** be approved by your applied faculty and then emailed to Concert Production (conpro@oberlin.edu). You will need to sign up for a recital scheduling appointment – more info will be emailed at a later date with links to appointments via SignUp Genius.

Students may begin reserving recital dates at the following times:

May 9, 2022.....	September 2, 2022 - November 23, 2022 (All Juniors and Seniors/MM/AD)
May 9, 2022.....	November 29, 2022 - December 13, 2022 (Shared Juniors and Seniors/MM/AD)
December 1, 2022*.....	February 1 - March 17, 2023 (Shared Juniors and Seniors/MM/AD)
February 6, 2023**.....	March 28 - May 5, 2023 (Seniors/MM/AD only)

* Lottery appointments via SignUp Genius (12/1/22 - 12/7/22, then first come first served)

** Lottery appointments via SignUp Genius (2/6/23 - 2/10/23, then first come first served)

Venues available for degree recitals are Kulas and Stull Recital Halls, Warner Concert Hall, the Birenbaum, Fairchild Chapel, and the Cat in the Cream Coffeehouse. (**Exception:** Finney Chapel may be requested for recitals involving organ.) If performing a degree recital outside of a conservatory venue – including remote recitals, the student will be responsible for contacting Concert Production to confirm that the recital was completed in order to receive credit with the registrar.

APPROVED RECITAL LENGTHS:

All degree recitals will include 30-minutes of setup time (**Exceptions:** when possible, more setup time will be reserved for organ, jazz, TIMARA and percussion)

- Juniors: max of 35 minutes of music

One hour of dress rehearsal per student may be scheduled one month prior to the recital date.

- Seniors/MM/AD: max of 50 minutes of music

Two hours of dress rehearsal may be scheduled one month prior to the recital date.

CANCELATION POLICY:

Degree recitals may not be scheduled on Mondays or against any conservatory-sponsored event of the same instrument.
